

Faringdon Town Youth FC Managers/Coaches Code of Conduct



When working with players, I will:

- place the well-being and the safety of each player above all other considerations, including the development of performance
- develop an appropriate supportive relationship with each player based on mutual trust and respect; have no favourites
- give praise for the positive aspects of a players performance and never ridicule or punish a player for their failings
- never engage in, or tolerate any form of bullying
- encourage and guide players to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and performance
- ensure that the activities are appropriate for the age, maturity, experience and the ability of the players
- not allow players of more than one year's age difference to participate in the same training or match session
- co-operate fully with specialists (e.g. other coaches, officials, sports scientists, doctors, physiotherapists) in the best interests of the player.
- consistently display high standards of behaviour

When attending matches, I will:

- adhere to the laws and the spirit of the game; promote fair play
- always have the correct equipment, including First Aid Kit, available
- show respect to others involved in the game including match officials, opposition players, coaches, managers and spectators
- never enter the field of play without the referee's permission
- never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour.
- consistently display high standards of behaviour and experience and be a role model for players, parents and spectators.
